

HOMEWORK GRADING RUBRIC
MATH 2255 SUMMER 2019

Selected homework problems will be graded out five points each according to the following rubric.

- 5 points: A complete and correct solution, with appropriate explanations and justifications, possibly with minor cosmetic errors.
- 4 points: A mostly correct solution with a minor mistake that impacts the final answer or somewhat incomplete work shown/explanations.
- 3 points: Several mistakes that impact the final answer and/or insufficient work shown or explanations.
- 2 points: Displays a misunderstanding of one or more of the key concepts of the question. Work shown/explanations are confused or simply not true.
- 1 point: A severe misunderstanding of the question and what it is asking for, with minimal explanation.
- 0 points: No attempt was made to answer the question, or an attempt was made, but no logical solution follows.
