Rewrite Guidelines

Please follow these guidelines when rewriting MA 361/2 assignments.

Due date: Unless otherwise specified, rewrites are due 2 weeks after the original due date.

Eligibility: Any exercise from the original assignment which you made an honest attempt to solve the first time is eligible to be rewritten. In particular, if you received a grade of 0/1 on an exercise (or did not submit a solution), then you may not rewrite that exercise for credit.

Partial rewrites: You may choose to resubmit a proper subset of the exercises on the original assignment. Only the exercises which you rewrite will be graded. If an exercise has multiple parts ((a), (b), (c), etc.), you may choose to resubmit only some of the parts. Only the parts which you rewrite will be graded.

Complete solutions: Any exercise (or part of an exercise, for exercises which consist of multiple parts (a), (b), ...) which you rewrite must be rewritten in full. Partial rewrites will not be graded.

New paper: All rewritten solutions must be submitted on a new sheet of paper, and must include the problem statement. Any changes made to your original submission will not be graded.

Attach original assignment: You must attach the <u>entire</u> original assignment to any rewritten solutions.

Grading: All rewritten solutions will be graded on their own merit, with no reference to your original solutions. You should address all of the grader's comments on your original solution; however, there is no guarantee that this will be sufficient to earn full credit.

You cannot lose points on the rewrite; your grade can only go up.
